Head Lice

This week we have identified several cases of head lice at school. Whilst head lice are nothing more than a nuisance, it is important that children are checked on a weekly basis so that they can be dealt with quickly before they are allowed to spread too far.

As there is an outbreak, we suggest that you check your child's hair as soon as possible and treat accordingly. It is vital that if you do need to treat your child that you continue to check with a nit comb and treat the hair again a week later.

If your child has been suffering with persistent re-infestation we are happy to put you in contact with the school nurse.
