Get in Touch

On a day to day basis many decisions are made to ensure we are providing the best education for all pupils in a safe environment. Such decisions take into account the needs of all pupils at Brockwood Primary and Nursery School. There may be occasions when you have a concern about your child's education or well-being whilst being a pupil at

Brockswood. In such an event you should follow the procedure below so the matter can be dealt with appropriately:

Step 1:

Bring the matter to the attention of the Class Teacher in the first instance who will listen to your concerns and act accordingly. You will receive a response to your concern within 5 days.

Step 2:

Following the response from the Class Teacher, if your concern isn't resolved to your satisfaction, you can take this further by requesting a meeting with the Senior Leadership Team. To request a meeting you should contact the school via email or telephone, or put your request in writing and hand it in at the office. A meeting will be arranged within 10 school days of the concern being registered - e.g. date of call/date of letter.

Step 3:

If you remain dissatisfied, please refer to our [school complaints policy](#).
