Enterprise Week will be Monday 10th - Friday 14th December. This exciting week will culminate in an afternoon of selling, trading, manning a stall and making as much profit as they can for their individual class projects.

The aims of the project are to develop our children's knowledge and understanding of entrepreneurial skills, how money is spent in designing and making products and primarily how they can contribute to a range of activities that help them to become more enterprising.

In preparation each class is allocated a budget with a remit of designing, advertising and making a product or game that can be marketed to members of the school community. Each class has been challenged to make a healthy profit and they will decide as a unit how to spend this in order to enrich their lives.

The children will be afforded the opportunity to enjoy themselves at each others stalls on Friday afternoon.

We have put a limit of £3 on the amount children will be able to spend. This is only payable through school comms and vouchers will be issued to the children.

Parents are invited to share this project with the children from 3.15pm - 4.15pm on Friday 14th December. You can collect your child as usual and they then will be able to take you round our Enterprise Fair, sharing their experiences with you.

NO cash will be accepted, vouchers have to be purchased using school comms, the deadline for this is Thursday 13th December. NO payments will be accepted after this. NO cash will be accepted on the day.

We look forward to seeing what amazing ideas our children come up with.
